## From the Desk of **Dr. Pramod Jog, IAP President, 2016**

Cocooned by a great team of OB, **EB** (Entire Bharat) & office staff, I am enjoying every moment of my presidential tenure.

IAP is made up of thousands of Individual Academicians & Practitioners . I believe in the tremendous potential of this 'Individual' pediatrician. A rational, ethical, healthy and happy pediatrician, treating children, will result in healthy, happy and bright children of India, ensuring the country's future. We should realize our own members' importance to the society. So, along with national & state conferences, we are encouraging and supporting small CMEs at grass root level with active participation of local pediatricians, considering the local problems to improve quality of practice. (Many pediatricians cannot attend National and State conferences – because of distance & time constraint). We are formulating a forum for involving practicing pediatricians in clinical research and database creation.

B stands for Beemari (illness). Never crib about your illness. One of my friends has an ambition to climb Mt. Everest even with fracture neck femur! Enjoy life with anti-diabetics & anti-hypertensives. Don't even discuss about your health problems in front of others.

C is climate. Climate is bound to be either hot, humid, cold or rainy. Why discuss about the climate when it's not going to change?. So never speak anything about ABC. If you avoid discussing these three things you will always remain positive.

The alphabet 'R' stands for Rationality. If you practice rationally, you will get the mental satisfaction. Form an informal group with a senior pediatrician as your Guru..driving force, meet periodically and introspect whether you are practicing



rationally.

A stands for being Academically updated. After we pass out our MD we get divided into 2 types of cells. T cells & B cells. T cells are the ones who become Teachers while B cells enter directly into Business. From our knowledge of immunology & conjugate vaccines, we know that the immune response is better when it is T cell dependent. So, I request our B cell colleagues to get attachment with some T cell (Teaching institute) so that they become academically updated & rational.

A child also teaches us to keep away from enemies of mind. Particularly ego. With seniority & position, some start developing ego. But remember, **EGO** Erases the **God** Out. Jealousy is another enemy. Never be jealous of your colleagues' practice, wealth, status ,achievements etc. Everyone has a different virtue which makes him/her great. Anger is the next enemy. If *you* get angry, the patient is likely to get angry. An angry patient is like an inflated balloon. It won't take time for this inflated balloon to fly off & reach neighboring pediatrician's chamber!

'O' stands for nurturing One extra quality in addition to academics and practice. There are many who maintain some hobby in life. Please nurture some hobby. It keeps us fresh. Hobbies like singing, dancing, painting, sports etc. rejuvenate us. Many of us have passion for singing. Singing is a boost for daily activities.

And **D** stands for **D**iscarding the bad memories. Let us reflect on the story of A &B. A&B were travelling in a desert. A was supposed to guide the path to B. Somehow A committed a mistake & B slapped him on the face. A wrote on the sand that B slapped him on the face. They continued the journey. At the end of the journey, A got tired. B carried him on the shoulders & completed the journey. At the end of the journey ,there is a hard rock, on which A wrote. When I was tired, B took me on the shoulders and completed the journey. Let us remember the moral of the story. Bad memories ,like someone slapping you on the face... should be written on the sand. so that they are washed away & forgotten. Good memories ,like someone helping you – should be written on the hard rock.....so that they are remembered forever.

I hope this vaccine called PRAMOD helps you in life.

#### **Paper Category: Free Papers**

The mode of presentation of free papers will be decided by the scrutinizing committee from amongst the abstracts received and authors will be informed accordingly. The papers not taken for `Oral' will be taken for `Poster'.

The text of the `Abstract' should contain not more than 250 words. It should be structured as far as possible in the following manner (Except Case Reports): (a) Introduction (b) Aims & Objectives (c) Material & Methods (including statistical methods where relevant) (d) Results (e) Conclusions.

#### Dr. SUNIL KUMAR SINGH MBBS, DCH

No words are enough for our dear friend Sunil. Born in a middle class family in Bihar, he graduated in Medical Sciences from one of the prestigious college of Bihar, AN Magadh Medical College, Gaya in 1990. After completing his Internship from the same he joined Junior Residency in Hindu Rao Hospital, Delhi in Pediatrics department. He got married and we were planning to have a big bash to celebrate his marriage anniversary this year but fate had something else in mind.

On the dreaded day of April 20th, 2016 he was shot dead in hospital OPD of C H C Jaspur, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand sending shock waves all around. It was unbelievable and still we are trying to come to terms. He joined the UP PMS services as adhoc Medical Officer and was posted in CHC Jaspur since last 16years as Senior Pediatrician. While in service he completed his DCH from Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. He was the only Pediatrician in the region and was well known and quite popular among patients. He was very humble and generous and far as I remember in the last 30 years since I have known him I have never seen him speaking any harsh words or behaving arrogantly with anybody.

He was devoted to his work and was always concerned for the welfare of the patients. Even on the fateful day being a holiday, he was examining patients in the OPD when he was shot dead from point blank with no chances of survival. He is survived by his home maker wife and two sons. The elder one is graduating this year in B. Tech, while the younger sibling has just passed 12th exams and is preparing for medical entrance as per his father's wish.

It's still unbelievable for me and all his friends and colleagues and we are still trying to come to terms. We are supporting his family in all the ways and means that we all can in this period of crisis. We will miss you Sunil...... may his soul rest in peace.


