
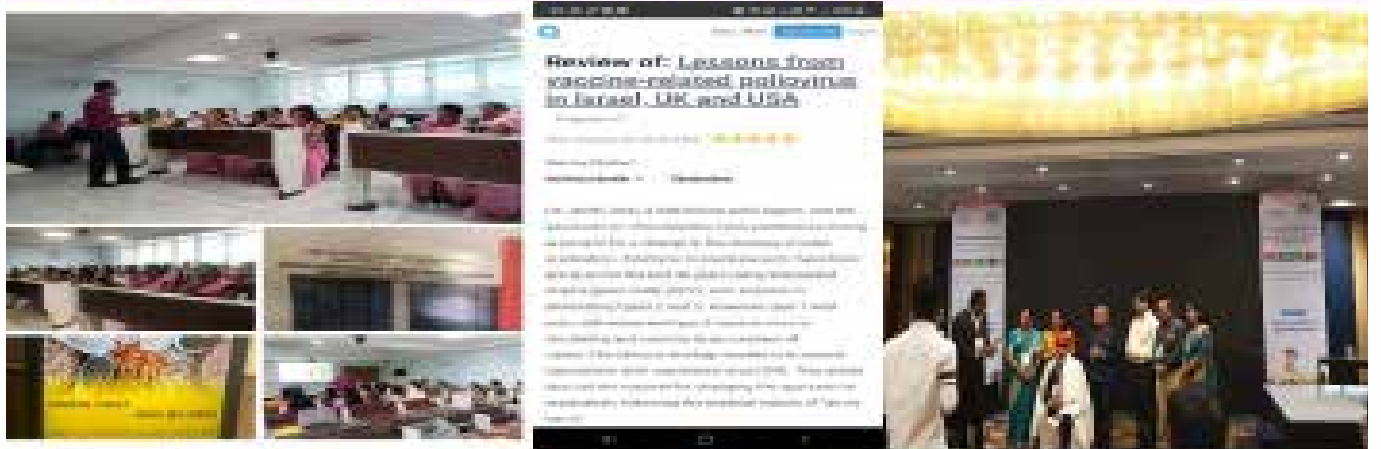

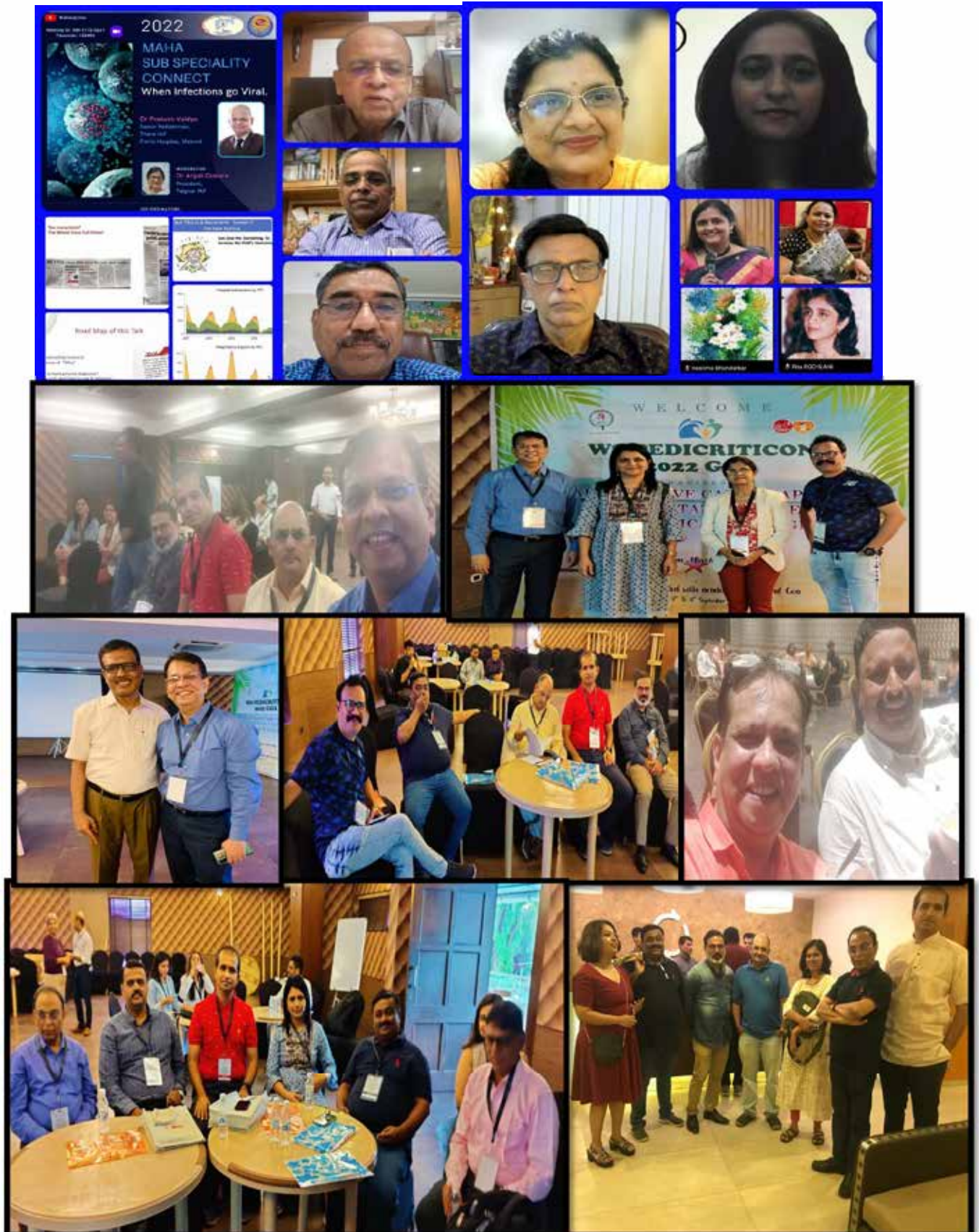

Table 1 Risk Factor based stratification for Follow up Care

| Risk Factor | Stratification | Follow up Care |

| Maternal | >17 weeks, >2.5kg, III trimester, Transient hypoglycemia, Suspected sepsis, Inadequate gestation, Occult IUGR (after accurate biometry) | Pediatrician |
| Neonatal | 31-34 weeks, 1500-2500 gms, III trimester, II, Sepsis, jaundice with exchange transfusion, <Grade II CTX, Prolonged meconium passage, Unconjugated bilirubin in neonates, Hypoglycemia >3 days, Need for water restriction | Neonatology / Developmental pediatrician |
| Infant | <1500 gms, <33 weeks, Multi organ injury, III trimester, >17 days respiratory, meningitis, bacteraemia, abnormal neurologic exam at discharge, PVL, periventricular haemorrhage or hypoplasia, low Apgar at 1 min, Vaginitis, hypoglycemia | Developmental Early Intervention Centre (DEIC) |
